How to use Research (international)? Which research is helpful? Strategies to support system change

How is Research used?

- By Government
- Theory Practical data to assist the arguments
- Praxis

We at first discussed about: what are we aming for? What do we want to get out of research?

- Development of theoretical knowledge, base for teaching and practice and theory
   From the experience of FGC, dynamic building up of knowledge
- Collecting international evaluations and papers on the European website
- Our Aim:

Rights for families (children and humans):

- Families getting "stronger"
- Decision making process
- Social outcomes
- Financial analysis can be helpful

We want to create a different framework to evaluate, layers of outcomes and values, supporting Family Democracy
